

Muskegon Wastewater Treatment Facility

Site Information: 11,000 acres of property currently treats a variety of different waste materials and products. This full service facility treats nearly all the public sewage generated in Muskegon County, serves as regional disposal facility for hauled wastes including restaurant grease and provides slow-rate land application irrigation for 5,100 acres of crops

Preferred Site Opportunities: Alternative energy facility taking advantage of available hauled brown grease. Potential for large dairy, dairy manufacturing, or greenhouse operations as recommended by target study.

Office Location: Seven (7) miles east of Apple Ave exit on US-31 to Maple Island Road, north 2 ¼ miles to just past White Road, turn right into the site , continue 1 ½ miles and follow the signs to the Administration Building.
